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Nancy A. Mundschenk, PhD, is an associate professor in the Department of Educational Psychology and Special Education at Southern Illinois University. Dr. Mundschenk provides ongoing staff development and consultation to parents, schools, teachers, and administrators in problem solving in a three-tier model of school supports and increasing meaningful parent participation in the educational decision-making process. She codirected a 3-year federally funded interdisciplinary collaboration training project, and she currently serves as a regional coordinator for a state-funded project to support early intervening services and response to intervention within a collaborative problem-solving model. Her research interests include students with emotional—behavioral disorders, collaborative service delivery, parent—family participation, data-based decision making, and autism spectrum disorders.
