


No-Glamour Social Language/Behavior Cards

Being Responsible: Card 1

Kittu was going on vacation. He asked John to feed his fish while he was gone. After Kittu left, John realized that he would be gone one of the days he was supposed to feed the fish.

- What could John do?
 ask a friend to feed the fish the day he is gone, give the fish extra food the
 day before he leaves
- Why is it good to have a friend watch your home while you're away? make sure nothing happens to your home, take care of pets, water plants and flowers
- What could Kittu do to thank John for taking care of his fish?
 buy him a gift on his vacation, pay him money, send him a post card, offer to return the favor



No-Glamour Social Language/Behavior Cards

Conversations: Card 1

Ashley sees some kids talking together. She wants to join them.

- Why is Ashley hanging back from the group?
 so she doesn't interrupt them, because they're talking together
- Why doesn't Ashley just go stand really close to them? They are busy; they haven't given her permission yet.
- What might happen if Ashley barged her way into the group?
 They might stop talking; they might be annoyed with her; they might be glad to include her.
- How will Ashley know when it's okay to join these kids?
 when at least one of them looks at her openly to acknowledge her,
 when they finish their conversation or switch the conversation topic



No-Glamour Social Language/Behavior Cards

Eating: Card 1

Margaret is eating lunch with her family. She wants some more juice.

- What is Margaret doing wrong? reaching over her food to get juice
- What might happen to Margaret's shirt? get food on it
- How could Margaret get some juice another way? ask someone to pass it to her
- How do you get second helpings of things at home when you want them?
 Answers will vary.



No-Glamour Social Language/Behavior Cards

Emotions: Card 1

Margaret drew a picture for her dad. She's giving it to him for his birthday present.

- How does Margaret feel? proud, happy
- What might Dad say to Margaret?
 "Thank you for the beautiful picture."
 "Did you draw this all by yourself? This is a wonderful birthday present."
- Margaret's dad received many nice presents for his birthday. Why does he think Margaret's picture is so special?

 She made it for him; it's handmade, not bought; she put a lot of effort into it; she's his daughter.
- What are some times you might give someone a gift besides a birthday? holiday, anniversary, get well, thank you, graduation, new baby, other special occasion
