

# Matt and Molly Are Going to P.E. Class

- Picture 1** Matt and Molly have P.E. class **today**. The **rule** in P.E. is that students need to wear shoes that have **rubber** soles and laces.
- Picture 2** Oh, no! Molly forgot about P.E. class and wore boots to school. Matt is worried that Molly won't be able to play in P.E. today.
- Picture 3** Molly says to the P.E. teacher, "I forgot to wear shoes with rubber **soles** and **laces**. May I still play in class today?" The P.E. teacher says, "No, Molly. It's **dangerous** to wear boots in P.E."

## Wh- Question

Why is it dangerous to wear boots in P.E.?  
because boots are slippery or because boots are loose  
(HINT FOR STUDENT — The answer to a "why" question is going to start with the word *because*.)

- Picture 4a** The P.E. teacher says, "The bottoms of your boots are slippery. If you don't have rubber soles, you could slip and hurt yourself." Molly says, "I understand. I'll just watch today."
- Picture 4b** The P.E. teacher says, "Your boots are loose. If you don't have laces, your boots could fly off your feet." Molly says, "I understand. I'll just watch today."

## Part of Speech — Noun

A *noun* is a word that is a person, place, or thing.

class	shoes	boots	feet
rule	soles	school	*Matt
students	laces	teacher	*Molly

\* We call the noun a *proper noun* if it is the name of a person, place, or thing.

## Suggested Props

Gymnasium — Write GYMNASIUM on a sheet of paper and hang it on a door.

Sign — Write "P.E. SHOES MUST HAVE RUBBER SOLES AND LACES." on colored paper and hang it above the door.

Boots — women's boots that can easily be slipped on and kicked off

Soccer ball

P.E. teacher — whistle around neck

Student — shoes with rubber soles and laces

Matt — white T-shirt and shoes with rubber soles and laces

Molly — red, pull-on skirt and boots
