Matt and Molly Are Going to the Park

- **Picture 1** It's a beautiful day! The sun is **shining** and the air is **warm**. Matt and Molly want to go to the park.
- **Picture 2** The park is too **far** to walk. Matt says, "Mom, would you drive Molly and me to the park?"
- Picture 3 Mom says, "Sure, but I lost my car keys. I remember laying them down in the kitchen somewhere." Matt and Molly need to help Mom find her car keys so they can go to the park. Molly gets an idea!

Wh-Question

Where does Molly find Mom's car keys? in the refrigerator or next to the sink (HINT FOR STUDENT — The answer to a "where" question is going to be <u>a place or a location</u>.)

- **Picture 4a** Molly says, "Mom, I remembered you had orange juice this morning. I **found** your keys in the refrigerator by the orange juice." Mom, Matt, and Molly laugh as they walk back to the car.
- **Picture 4b** Molly says, "Mom, I remembered you washed the dishes this morning. I found your keys next to the sink." Mom, Matt, and Molly laugh as they walk back to the car.

Part of Speech — Noun

A noun is a word that is a person, place, or thing.

sun	orange juice	sink
park	car	*Mom
keys	refrigerator	*Matt
kitchen	dishes	*Molly

* We call the noun a proper noun if it is the name of a person, place, or thing.

Suggested Props

Window — any window in the room

Set of keys

Refrigerator — If a play refrigerator is not available, get a large cardboard box. Turn the box on its side. Use one of the flaps on the box as a door or use a knife to cut a door.

Orange juice — empty container from home

- Sink If a play sink is not available, get a cardboard box. Make the sink's basin by cutting a rectangular hole in the top. Draw a faucet and knobs next to the hole.
- Car two chairs for the front seat and two chairs for the backseat

Mom — big, long necklace

Matt — white T-shirt

Molly — red, pull-on skirt
