# The Telephone

#### Words to Know

braille: a writing and printing system for the blind that uses raised dots directories: lists of names and addresses, usually in alphabetical order impairment: injury, damage, something that is less than normal index: a listing, usually in alphabetical order, of what is covered in a book or paper; often found in the back of the book

Many of us use the telephone daily. We use it to talk to friends and to get information. We use the telephone book to find the phone numbers of friends or businesses. We use it to find services to help us.

There are two parts of the telephone directory we will study. One is the white pages. The other is the yellow pages. In some large cities or towns these may be two different books.





## Alphabetical Order

Before you can find something in the telephone directory, you need to know how to put words in alphabetical order. Names are listed in the same order as the alphabet. If the first letter of two names is the same, use the second letter. For example, if you see the names *Cate* and *Coat*, you would look at the second letter. The letter "A" comes before "O," so Cate is listed before Coat. If the first and second letters are the same, go to the third letter to decide which name comes first.

### White Pages

The white pages of the telephone directory list people and businesses. The listing will tell you the phone number and address. All of the names are all listed in alphabetical order.

The names of people are listed by last name first. If you are looking for Jean T. Bell's phone number or address, you would look under "B." The listing would look like this.

Bell, Jean T. 413 West Street. . . 567-4111

You must know a person's last name in order to look up the listing.

Sometimes you may find that there are several people with the same last name. Then you look at the first name. They, too, will be listed in alphabetical order. It is important to know the address of the person you are looking up, as well.

#### Guide Words

Every page in the directory has guide words at the top of the page. These guide words tell you the first listing on the page and the last listing on the page. The guide words will help you find what you're looking for more easily. You will know what is on each page. Look at the part of the directory page below.

The first listing on the page is Greene, Betina. The guide words listed Greene first. This tells you that "Greene" will be first on that page. "Greerer" is the second guide word. That tells you that Greerer will be the last name on that page.
