



Exaggerating Articulatory Movements

Task 7: Production of Exaggerated Monosyllabic Words Containing Final Consonant Blends

Procedures

Imitation: Clinician says stimulus item once. Client repeats the item one to five times.

Delayed Imitation: Clinician says stimulus item, and immediately holds up one hand to impose a delay. Clinician then signals client to respond, and client repeats the item once.

Correction: Clinician says the stimulus item incorrectly (e.g., too rapidly, misarticulated). Client then produces the item correctly once.

Reading: Clinician points to printed stimulus. Client reads aloud without a verbal model from the clinician.
