General Copyright Policy

Fees are imposed on a case by case basis, are non refundable, and also subject to change without notice. PRO-ED does not apply any discounts to copyright permission fees. PRO-ED requires payment for your request prior to granting permission and releasing any materials. A confirmation letter will be sent to you upon receipt of payment. All fees are due prior to the release of any material or granting of permission and are not refundable. Should PRO-ED in its sole discretion, determine the use of our material is contrary to the original intent as we understood it in your letter requesting permission, we reserve the right to demand that you cease and desist in your use of PRO-ED's material and remove it from the marketplace. Given the volume of requests, copyright permission requests can take approximately four weeks to process. If applying for a free test kit for dissertation/thesis purposes, please allow an additional 2-3 weeks to process your request.
