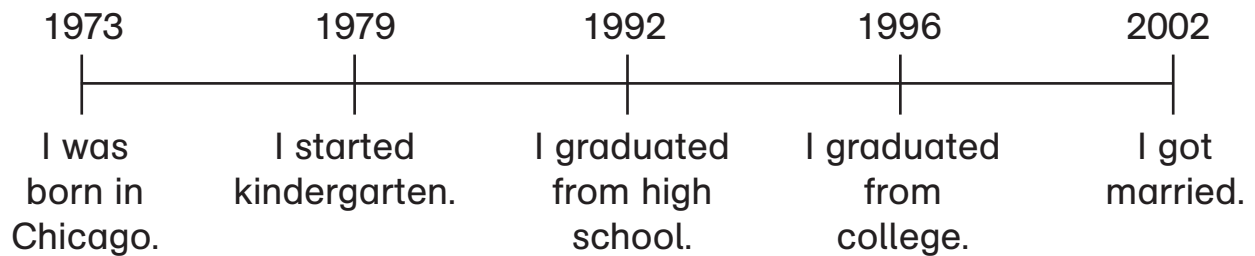

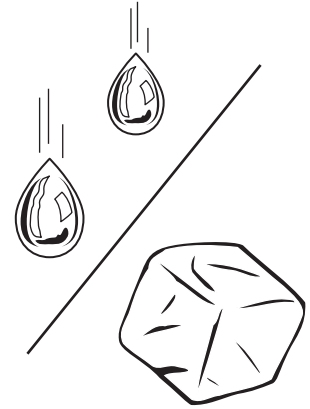

Fill in the circle next to the correct answer.

Water is made up of small, moving parts called molecules. The molecules in water are always moving. The molecules in hot water move **rapidly** back and forth. When the water gets colder, the molecules slow down. The molecules line up in a pattern. They form ice crystals. When all the molecules become ice crystals, the water becomes **solid**. So, water freezes when the molecules slow down and form ice crystals.
