

## BANANA SPLIT ♥ ♣

**Setup:** Fan the deck facedown. (Variation: Use a partial deck.)

### Procedure

1. Ask the client to choose a card and place it on the table faceup.
2. Tell the client to say “banana” the next time he sees the card.
3. Put the card back in the deck and shuffle.
4. Give the client the deck facedown.
5. The client stacks each card faceup at a rate of one per second. He stops when he sees the target card and says, “Banana.”

## BROKEN HEART STORY ♥

**Setup:** Take out the following cards from a deck and sequence them in this order: Q♥, 5♦, 2♠, J♣, J♠, 10♣, 8♣, J♦, K♥, 2♥

### Procedure

1. Read the following story aloud, placing each card in a row faceup at the appropriate time to help illustrate the story:  
“The **queen of hearts** had a ring with **five diamonds**. The king became suspicious of the queen and had his **two (of spades)** bodyguards, the **jack of clubs** and the **jack of spades**, watch her. One day at **ten (of clubs)** minutes before **eight (of clubs)** o’clock, the queen left the castle to visit her friend the **jack of diamonds**. When the **king of hearts** learned about her visit, his heart was broken in **two (of hearts)**.”
2. Collect the cards in order and give them to the client. The client retells the story while placing the cards in sequence.
