

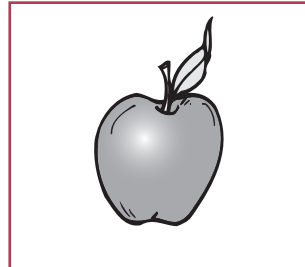
# What Is a Detail?

---

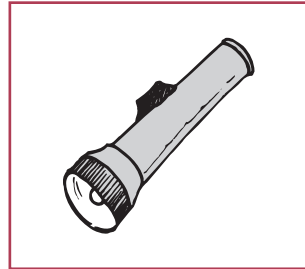
A **detail** is a fact. It tells you a small bit of information about something.

1. It barks.



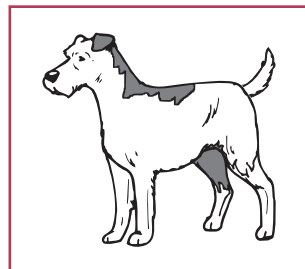
